WHEREAS: The FMCUSA Board of Administration is "responsible for policy, procedural, financial, and legal issues during the interim between General Conference sessions" (BOD ¶ 4320.A), and WHEREAS a Conference Superintendent is the principle leader of each Annual Conference, working closely with her/his designated bishop to give input into and implement denominational mission and policy (see BOD ¶ 5120), and WHEREAS Conference Superintendents currently gather regularly in what is called the Superintendent's Leadership Team (SLT), there is nothing in the Book of Discipline that gives guidance as to the responsibilities or authority granted the SLT as a body, and WHEREAS the current nomination and election process for elders to the Board of Administration does not guarantee that any Conference Superintendents would be elected to the BOA, potentially removing the vital and necessary input of the Superintendency from BOA decisions, Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED: That BOD paragraph 4300.A.2 be added to, such that it will state: 2. sufficient additional elders to give a total of twelve clergy (equal representation from each US area – North, South and West); , with three of these elders being one Superintendent from each area, named to the BOA by the area Bishop. Additional Superintendents may be elected by General Conference delegates, if nominated.
