SINCE GC19 GREENVILLE UNIVERSITY...

- Developed the SMART Center on the town square providing a common space for students and community.
- Launched the Kindergarten Readiness Program to benefit students in the community and provide training ground for early childhood education majors.
- Partnered with GrowPro Genetics to utilize GU's greenhouse to breed soft red winter wheat and provide hands-on experience for biology students.
- Launched Toastiez Restaurant on the town square providing an alternative revenue source and an increased opportunity for student jobs.
- Acquired the Contemporary Music Center (CMC) in Nashville, TN, which offers an immersive semester
 experience to students from all over the U.S.
- Became one of the few institutions to remain open during the COVID19 pandemic, partnering with The University of Illinois Systems in saliva testing to control outbreaks.
- Hired a chaplain and revamped chapel to The Wednesday Experience, Encounter, and Small Groups.
- Launched a nursing program in partnership with St. John's College of Nursing.
- Implemented an equestrian program to begin fall 2023.
- Partnered with Faith Presbyterian Hospice in Dallas, TX to teach students compassionate holistic healthcare with a focus on end-of-life care.
- Launched a men's and women's gymnastics program, competing with big ten schools all over the nation.
- Opened the Greenville Gymnastics Center, providing lessons to children in our community, and student jobs.
- Formalized a student success tracking system to ensure no student falls through the cracks.
- Initiated a growing Outdoor Adventure Club that is aiding in recruitment and retention.
- Obtained ABET accreditation for our engineering program.
- Constructing a new 246 bed residence hall with classrooms for nursing and the sciences. Completion Jan. 2024.
- Constructing the W. Richard Stephens Fieldhouse & Robert "Ish" Smith Museum at the Strahl Athletic Complex. Completion Jan. 2024.
