In partnership with Alaska Bible College (Palmer, AK) and Skyline Family Fellowship, FMC (Eagle River, AK) a group of guys from around the USA visited Alaska in the summer of 2021.

This MMI group led, by Supt. Ben Tolly, spent 5 days in and around south central Alaska, exploring various parks, hiking trails, and fishing streams.

When they were not taking in the sights and sounds that are unique to the Alaska experience, these men were hard at work painting classrooms at Alaska Bible College and rebuilding emergency stairs at our lone Free Methodist Alaskan church.

Additionally, this group of men had morning and evening devotionals, conversations that enabled those attending to take time away the everyday rhythms of life to not only connect with God, but grow deeper in relationship with other men of faith.

This was the first of what is hoped will be many more outreach, projects, and playful adventures in partnership with Free Methodist and others kingdom ministries taking place in Alaska.

This second MMI trip to Alaska, a group of men from England, the Midwest and California, were hosted by Skyline Family Fellowship, FMC (Eagle River, AK). This MMI group was led by Terry Beasley Bryan Sallee. They spent several days working on a variety of work projects at Skyline Family Fellowship, as well as camping on the Kenai River experiencing world class sockeye salmon fishing.

The purpose of this trip was three-fold:

- -Nurture relationships of Free Methodist men from a variety of conferences
- -Complete numerous work projects at Skyline Family Fellowship that would enable their facility to be used by several non-profits and homeschool networks in the community
- -Create a space for men to cultivate their relationship with God through the mediums of work projects and outdoor adventures.

The desired outcomes of this group were above and beyond what could have been expected. The relationships and memories created continue to open the door for more MMI-Alaska trips. Ideally, future work projects and outdoor adventures in Alaska will open more doors to serve the Free Methodist church in Alaska and other ministries in need of assistance.
