# We are protecting the vulnerable.

## 2022 was a year of recovery and growth.

The pandemic limited us in many ways, but **we are now fully engaging with more than 140 leaders in 14 countries.** Set Free Leaders are extending care, training, raising awareness, providing for physical needs, and more to reduce human trafficking vulnerabilities in the communities they call home.

**Our vision is to see the vulnerable protected, captives set free, and the oppressed experiencing hope and healing as neighborhoods are transformed.**

## How we are protecting the vulnerable:

- Set Free teams in Hungary and Bulgaria are **coming alongside Ukrainians** displaced by the war. They are providing awareness, education, and safe housing options for refugees.
- Julia in Pennsylvania is working with local organizations to **raise awareness and provide self defense trainings** in her community.
- Nayan works with the local government to repatriate dozens of missing and trafficked children in India.
- Ken in the Philippines is **training children and their families** about the dangers of online sexual exploitation of children.
- The Seattle, WA and Spring Arbor, MI teams are working within a broken system to **bless foster families, children and teens, and social workers.**
- The team in Decatur, IL is coming alongside their city government to create proclamations against human trafficking.





## OUR WORK

Our mission is to mobilize faith communities, financial partners, and all segments of society towards ending human trafficking and creating new futures through community-based action.

## Child and Youth Protection:

Teams across the globe bring hope and healing to children that are vulnerable to being trafficked through awareness, prevention, and intervention methods. They educate, advocate, support, and mentor children to increase their resilience to human trafficking.


## Rebuilding Community:

We are directly serving those most vulnerable to human trafficking by working to rebuild and mobilize communities. Set Free leaders and teams address the root causes of human trafficking in their neighborhoods, including poverty, racism, gender inequality, addiction, abuse, family brokenness, and more by extending mercy to the margins.

## Education, Awareness, and Training:

Leaders create locally-informed awareness campaigns and equip community members with training. Raising awareness is an essential way to come alongside those most vulnerable to human trafficking. Through this dedicated training, equipping, educating, and advocating, communities come together to reduce the vulnerabilities of human trafficking.
