Evening Prayer

In the name of the Father, and the Son and The Holy Spirit, Amen.

WORDS OF PRAISE - “My eyes are awake before each watch of the night that I may meditate on your promise. In your steadfast love hear my voice; O Lord, in your justice preserve my life. Those who persecute me with evil purpose draw near; they are far from your law. Yet you are near, O Lord, and all your commandments are true. Long ago I learned from your decrees that you have established them forever” (Psalm 119:148 –152).

SILENT REFLECTION
(Quiet Moment/Remember Your Day)

PRAYER OF CONFESSION- Almighty and most merciful God, we have erred and strayed from your ways like lost sheep. Too often we have followed the desires and devices of our own hearts. We have offended against your holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; and we have done those things which we ought not to have done. There is no health in us. But in our misery, O Lord, you have mercy upon us. Spare those who confess their faults. Restore those who are penitent according your promises declared to humanity in Christ Jesus our Lord. Grant O Merciful Father that for Jesus sake we might live a godly, righteous and sober life. To the glory of your holy name. Amen.

COLLECT - Almighty God, unto whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: cleanse the thoughts of our hearts, by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love You and worthily magnify Your holy name, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

RESPONSE OF TRUST- O Lord, you have spoken today, Though I am often slow to hear, Now I rest and trust in you.

O Lord, you have been my protection today, Though I have looked to other things for safety, Now I rest and trust in you.

O Lord, you have loved me as your child today, Though I have often run from my Father, Now I return, I rest, and I trust in you.

EVENING COLLECT - O God from whom all holy desires, all good counsels, and all just work do proceed; give unto your servants that peace which the world cannot give, that our hearts may be set to obey your commandments and being defended against our enemies, we may pass our time in rest and quietness, through Jesus Christ our savior, Amen.
